





UPDATE <mark>(03.12.2020</mark>)

Further to many enquiries we have received regarding decisions you are making whether to move your horses before or after 31st December 2020:

We understand some of you may have flexibility on when you make the decision about your horse's travel date and have decided to wait and see if a UK/EU Trade Deal is agreed at the highest level and whether this might allow some deviations from the information we have distributed thus far. Others have earlier deadlines for making decisions regarding date of travel. We cannot anticipate when or if a Trade Deal will be agreed or the impact of a Trade Deal on horse movements, so can perhaps only give some context. We are strongly advised to plan for the requirements that follow in the slides below.

Some context...

- If there is a Trade Agreement at the highest level between EU and UK then it may be followed by a veterinary sub-agreement. Such an agreement would be the result of a subsequent technical negotiation which would hopefully allow facilitated movement of horses.
- If there is a Trade Agreement at a high level it is likely that transition rules would be put in place in order to allow time for technical negotiation. In an ideal situation the current system for moving horses would be permitted to continue during the transition period.
- However this is NOT guaranteed. Your preparations and risk planning may incorporate this possibility but should not in any way focus or depend on it. We are strongly advised to plan for the requirements that follow in the slides below.
- Customs is not expected to have any derogations regardless of a UK/EU Trade Agreement.








FOALS AT FOOT (03.12.2020)

- ✤ Health Certificates: Need to accompany a foal of any age.
- Blood work needs to be done for the foal and the foal cannot travel on the mare's blood results.
- The full 30 day 'kept apart from equidae of different health status'' must be completed for the foal. The 90 day residency can be less in the case of younger animals but the 30 day clause cannot be reduced. So the foal must be minimum 30 days age when HC is signed.
- Similarly for EU recognised studbook foals we anticipate they would need to be minimum 40 days old in order to complete the 40 days veterinary supervision required for entry to EU on temporary health papers. TBC.
- Microchip and passport are mandatory for travel of the foal to the EU.







WALK IN MARES (03.12.2020)

- ✤ Referring to Walk in Mares IRL > UK > IRL:
- \Box Health conditions for entry IRL > UK:
- These are not yet published.
- □ Health conditions for return UK > IRL:
- Currently return to IRL would be limited by the need for:
- Mare to complete 30 days separated from horses of a different health status before travel UK > IRL.
- Foals at Foot would need to be 30 days old before returning UK > IRL.
- Updates to be provided as soon as available.







CURRENT POSITION

- FROM JANUARY 1st 2021 THE TRANSITION PERIOD ENDS AND THE UK WILL NO LONGER BE PART OF THE EU.
- TRACES/DOCOM & TRI-PARTITE AGREEMENT NO LONGER IN PLACE.
- IF A DEAL IS REACHED AND TRADE BETWEEN EU AND UK CAN CONTINUE THE UK WILL BE IN GROUP A FROM AN EQUINE HEALTH PERSPECTIVE. THIS IS THE SAME AS AUSTRALIA, NEW ZEALAND, SWITZERLAND AND NORWAY.
- CHANGES TO HEALTH CERTIFICATION AND HORSEBOX LICENSING WILL COME INTO FORCE IMMEDIATELY AS WELL AS ADDITIONAL CUSTOMS & LOGISTICS PROCEDURES.
- HEALTH CERTIFICATION TO TRAVEL HORSES FROM UK TO NORTHERN IRELAND AFTER JANUARY 1st 2021 CURRENTLY SEEMS TO BE THE SAME AS IT WILL BE FOR UK TO IRELAND (EU PROTOCOLS)







CURRENT POSITION

- IF A DEAL IS REACHED BETWEEN EU AND UK: FEI REGISTERED HORSES WILL BE PERMITTED TO ENTER INTO EU ON A TEMPORARY OR PERMANENT BASIS. A DIFFERENT HEALTH CERTIFICATE IS REQUIRED DEPENDING ON THE LENGTH OF STAY IN EUROPE.
- THE EU MAY NOT AUTOMATICALLY RECOGNISE HORSES REGISTERED WITH NON-EU STUDBOOKS. IN THIS CASE THESE UK STUD BOOK HORSES WOULD BE DEEMED UNREGISTERED UNTIL THE STUDBOOKS BECOME EU RECOGNISED.
- UNREGISTERED HORSES (HORSES REGISTERED WITH STUDBOOKS NOT RECOGNISED BY THE EU) MAY ONLY ENTER INTO THE EU ON PERMANENT HEALTH PAPERS.
- PERMANENT ENTRY HAS A LONGER PREPARATION PERIOD (90 DAYS PREPARATION) THAN TEMPORARY ENTRY (40 DAYS PREPARATION).



8.	CONSIDER AVOIDING TRAVEL EU/UK OR UK/EU IN JANUARY 2021.	ARRANGE MOVEMENTS IN DECEMBER 2020 OR FEBRUARY 2021.
9.	FOR A PERMANENT ENTRY INTO EU ON 1 ST JANUARY 2021 THE 90 DAYS RESIDENCY IN EU/UK WOULD BEGIN ON 1 ST OCTOBER 2020. PEDEN BLOODSTOCK WILL ALWAYS ADVISE YOU OF THE DATE TO START MONITORING/RESIDENCY BASED ON THE EXACT DATE OF CERTIFICATION & SHIPPING OF YOUR HORSE.	HORSE MAY ONLY BE RESIDENT IN UK OR EU DURING THESE 90 DAYS - THE FINAL 30 DAYS THE HORSES MUST BE KEPT SEPARATE FROM HORSES OF A DIFFERENT HEALTH STATUS AND BE IN THE UK. 11.	EQUINE INFECTIOUS ANAEMIA – MUST BE DONE WITHIN 90 DAYS OF EXPORT FOR TEMPORARY AND WITHIN 30 DAYS FOR PERMANENT ENTRY TO THE EU.	A GOVERNMENT APPROVED LAB MUST BE USED. PEDEN BLOODSTOCK WILL ADVISE ON THE DATE YOU MAY TAKE THE SAMPLE ONCE AN EXPORT DATE IS AGREED.
12.	EQUINE VIRAL ARTERITIS - FOR ENTIRE MALES OVER 180 DAYS OF AGE EVA VNT WITHIN 21 DAYS OF EXPORT. FOR HORSES WITH POSITIVE EVA VNT A SEMEN VI TEST CAN BE DONE, OR STRICT VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS CAN BE MET.	PEDEN BLOODSTOCK WILL ADVISE YOU FURTHER BASED ON YOUR INDIVIDUAL HORSE AND BASED ON YOUR SHIPMENT DATE.
13.	APPLICATIONS FOR HEALTH CERTIFICATES MUST BE MADE TO DEFRA 7-10 DAYS BEFORE TRAVEL. PEDEN WILL MAKE THESE APPLICATIONS FOR YOU. <u>ENTERING THE UK</u>

- CURRENTLY THE FINAL HEALTH CERTIFICATE FROM EU UK NOT PUBLISHED FOR EQUINES. INITIAL DETAIL HAS BEEN RELEASED:
- REGISTERED HORSES (EU APPROVED STUDBOOKS AND NATIONAL BRANCHES OF FEI) MAY ENTER UK FROM EU WITHOUT ANY TESTING OR RESIDENCY.
- NON REGISTERED HORSES (CURRENTLY INCLUDES HORSES REGISTERED WITH A UK STUDBOOK) WILL
 REQUIRE EIA WITHIN 30 DAYS AND EVA WITHIN 21 DAYS
 (OR VACCINATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGS) & 40
 DAYS RESIDENCY AND 30 DAYS ISOLATION.
- HORSES ENTERING UK AND STAYING FOR OVER 90 DAYS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH A UK PASSPORT ISSUING ORGANISATION WITHIN 30 DAYS OF IMPORTING INTO THE UK.
- ENTRY FROM 3rd COUNTRY TO UK NO HEALTH CERT CHANGES JUST NOTIFICATION/ PROCEDURAL CHANGES.







ENTERING THE UK

- HORSES ENTERING THE UK BETWEEN 1st JANUARY 2021 AND JULY 2021 WILL NOT NEED TO PASS THROUGH A BORDER CONTROL POST.
- SPOT CHECKS WILL BE DONE BY DEFRA AT THE POINT OF DESTINATION IN THE UK DURING THIS INITIAL 6 MONTH PERIOD.
- CUSTOMS FORMALITIES WILL NEED TO BE ADHERED TO AND STOPS ON ENTRY TO THE UK ARE ANTICIPATED TO BE REQUIRED FOR CUSTOMS PURPOSES. IT IS NOT ANTICIPATED HORSES WILL NEED TO BE UNLOADED FOR THIS CUSTOMS STOP.








CUSTOMS

- CUSTOMS CLEARANCE WILL BE REQUIRED WHEN TRAVELLING EU/UK OR UK/EU.
- IMPORT TAXES WILL BE DUE TO BE PAID HOWEVER THERE SHOULD BE VARIOUS EXEMPTIONS IN PLACE.
- FOR EXAMPLE THROUGH THE USE OF THE ATA CARNET SYSTEM.
- PEDEN BLOODSTOCK WILL ASSIST YOU TO HANDLE THESE REQUIREMENTS.








ENTRY OF DOGS FROM UK TO EU

If the UK is not listed by the EU then the below applies:

- 1. You must have your dog, cat or ferret microchipped.
- 2. Vaccinate your dog, cat or ferret against rabies your pet must be at least 12 weeks old before it can be vaccinated.
- 3. Your pet must have a blood sample taken at least 30 days after its primary rabies vaccination (from a current series of vaccinations). Your vet may recommend a booster rabies vaccination before this test.
- 4. Your pet's blood sample will be sent to an EU-approved blood testing laboratory.
- 5. Wait 3 months from the date the successful blood sample was taken before you can travel.
- 6. The vet must give you a copy of the test results and enter the day the blood sample was taken in an animal health certificate (AHC).
- 7. You must also take your pet to your vet no more than 10 days before travel to get an AHC. (The AHC needs to be signed by an official vet. Check with your vet that they can issue AHCs for pets.)
- 8. You must take proof of: your pet's microchipping date; your pet's vaccination history; a successful rabies antibody blood test result
- 9. Your pet's AHC will be valid for:10 days after the date of issue for entry into the EU; onward travel within the EU for 4 months after the date of issue; re-entry to Great Britain for 4 months after the date of issue
- 10. You must enter through a Travellers Point of Entry for an inspection
- 11. A new HC is required for each trip to the EU
- 12. Travel from EU to UK unaffected (tapeworm treatment) and you can use the outbound HC to re-enter UK up to 4 months later.
- 13. Please ALWAYS refer to the Defra website for the most up to date information.
- 14. Requirements for travel of dogs EU UK are to follow in due course once on hand.







ENTRY OF OTHER GOODS

- PLEASE BE AWARE OTHER GOODS ON THE HORSEBOX MAY BE SUBJECT TO CONTROLS.
- FOR EXAMPLE FEED AND BEDDING MAY NEED PHYTOSANITARY DOCUMENTATION, WILL NEED TO BE NOTIFIED TO THE RELEVANT AUTHORITIES BEFORE TRAVEL AND CUSTOMS MAY BE APPLICABLE FOR TRAVEL EU/UK AND UK/EU.
- RESTRICTIONS, LICENCING AND CUSTOMS MAY ALSO BE APPLICABLE TO VETERINARY MEDICINES TRAVELLING EU/UK AND UK/EU.
- FURTHER INFORMATION SHOULD FOLLOW IN THE COMING WEEKS.
