

2020 PRESS RELEASE

For its 42^{nd} edition, the FEI JUMPING WORLD CHALLENGE series continues to provide less experienced Jumping Riders with an opportunity to compete in an International setting without having to leave their country.

A total of 296 competitions were organized worldwide in 2019 as opposed to 332 in 2018. 39 countries took part in the 2019 edition of the Challenge which is considerably less than in 2018 (47) and explains the lower number of competitions organized. More NFs were meant to take part but had to cancel their events.

This year, the course plans were designed by Mr. Christoph Johnen of Germany. As a very experienced course designer form many CSIs around the world, Mr. Johnen was the Course Designer for the 2016 FEI Jumping World Final in Rabat, Morocco.

The FEI Jumping World Challenge FINAL 2019 took place in Quito, Ecuador where a total of 21 Athletes of 16 different Nationalities competed over 5 days in an incredible setting.
