2021 FEI EVENTING EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIPS

Derogation to the Minimum Eligibility Requirements

Taking into account the number of Events cancelled and the travel restrictions that has limited the number of opportunities to compete at long format competitions during the past year, the FEI Board approved to line-up the qualification requirements for the 2021 FEI Eventing European Championships with the current qualification requirements in place for the Olympic Games, by prolonging the MER period for one year.

Standard Minimum Eligibility requirements to participate in a 4* level Championships - FEI Eventing rules Art 518.1 & 521:

Each combination must obtain a CCI4*-L MER between 1 January 2020 and the FEI Nominated entry date.

The period for obtaining a MER for Championships is from the preceding calendar year to the closing of the championship nominated entries.

Specific MER procedure approved by the FEI Board for the 2021 FEI Eventing European Championships:

Based on the recommendation of the Eventing Committee, the same concept as for the Tokyo Olympic Games will apply to the 2021 FEI European Championships with a “**confirmation result**” concept and to extend the MER period from **01 January 2019** to 2021 nominated entries requiring **one MER at CCI4*-L or CCI5*-L**.

However, should the above MER be obtained in 2019, one CCI4*-S MER must be obtained from 01 January 2020 to 2021 nominated entries as a confirmation result.

Such confirmation result must be obtained with a clear Cross Country round on obstacles (activating a maximum of one frangible device (11 Penalty points) or missing one flag (15 penalty points) will maintain the Confirmation Result on Cross Country).
