

**FEI WBFSH World Breeding Eventing Championships for Young Horses
 Le Lion d'Angers (FRA) 17-20 October 2019**

I. Participation / Invitations:

Athletes are invited by the Organising Committee through their NF (Art. 116 will apply).

A **total of 110 horses** will be allowed to participate: 40 six-year old horses in the CH- 2* / 70 seven-year old horses in the CH- 3*.

Maximum number of horses per NF (including host NF):	3 for the CH- 2* & 12 for the CH-3*

Maximum number of horse per athlete:

2 horses per athlete for the entire event: whether 2 in the CH- 2* if not limited by excessive number of entries whether 2 in the CH- 3* if not limited by excessive number of entries whether 1 in the CH- 2*+ 1 in the CH- 3*

Case of excessive entries:

In case of excessive entries (more than 110 horses for both competitions), a ballot system based on FEI Eventing Horse Ranking (established for the purpose of this championship only) will apply, and taking into account the limit of authorized quota of horses per nation, to be determined on the date of the nominative entries: All the horses with the same number of points of the 40th ranked horse for the 6 year olds and 70th ranked horse for the 7 year olds on the list will be accepted.

The slots in the Rankings are attributed to the national Federations and are not nominative. Each Horse guaranties a slot for his Nation but the final selection of combinations belongs to the National Federation.

II. Minimum Eligibility Requirements as per Art. 521

All qualifying events must be achieved as a combination.

	Minimum qualifying events to achieve
Young Horse Championship 6 years old	1 CCI2*-S with zero obstacle penalties on XC and max 4 penalties on obstacles (max one rail down) in the Jumping test
Young Horse Championship 7 years old	1 CCI2*-L + 1 CCI3*-S , both with zero obstacle penalties on XC and max 4 penalties on obstacles (max one rail down) in the Jumping test

III. ENTRIES

Competitors are entered by the Organising Committee through their NF (Art. 116)

Entries in Principle: 19 August 2019

Nominated Entries: 17 September 2019

Definite Entries: 8 October 2019

IV. WBFSH STUDBOOK

FEI Prizes at FEI Young Horses Championships:

- FEI Plates (gold, silver and bronze) engraved to be offered to the horse owner. If the horse owner is not present in the venue, the athlete must accept it on behalf of the horse owner.
- Horse owners must accompany the placed (or winning) horses (or enter on the placed –or winning) carriages in driving. If the horse owner is not present at the venue it must be represented by the athlete.
- Horses must enter the arena wearing the blanket (if applicable), a sash around the horses' neck and a big rosette on the sash at the level of the chest (gold, silver bronze).
- Small FEI Plates (gold, silver, bronze) engraved to be offered to the athlete (text to be: athlete of the winner/second/third of the "FEI WBFSH [discipline] World Championships for Young Horses [year]).
- The national flags (no studbook flags) to be used at the prize giving ceremony are the ones of the countries of the studbooks of the first 3 placed horses.
- The national anthem to be played is the one of the country of the studbook of the winning horse.
- Longines shall have the right to offer watches to the athletes.
- The World Breeding Federation for Sport Horses (WBFSH) and/or the organiser shall have the possibility to offer a recognition (to be agreed in conjunction with the FEI) to the breeder and/or studbook.

Studbooks Trophy

A classification will be established between the studbooks members of the WBFSH. The winning studbook is the one with the lowest total of penalty points, after adding together the final score of the 3 highest placed competitors. All horses registered in a stud book member of the WBFSH entering the FEI World Breeding Eventing Championships for Young Horses are automatically entered to participate in the Breeding Trophy for Young Horses - Eventing. The FEI entry form online must be completed entirely. All information to concerning the studbook is compulsory and must be filled in entirely. The native studbook member will check the information given on the entry FEI entry system form to take part in the World Breeding Trophy for Young Horses - Eventing. The entry form must be filled in entirely. It corresponds to the standard norms of the FEI entry, as well as the information requested by the OC for the participation in the Breeding Trophy for Young Horses - Eventing. The FEI gives the information to the studbook for validation. The 3 first studbook teams will compulsory be present at the prize giving ceremony. Athletes riding their horses:
