As per the FEI Policies on Rules Revision Process and Periodical Rules Revision we are pleased to provide you with templates for you to provide us with your rule(s) change(s) proposal(s).

Please note that only proposals submitted using the respective templates that can be found <u>here</u> and sent through the <u>Rules Revision Platform</u> by **1 March 2024** at the latest will be taken into consideration by the FEI.

## **USERS GUIDE:**

- We have created 1 specific template for the Equine Anti-Doping & Controlled Medication Regulations that are subject to full review in 2024.
- In addition, we have created a general template in case that you: 1) would like to propose changes to other FEI Rules should these proposals fall within one of the 6 criteria define in the <u>Periodical Rules Revision Policy</u>, or; 2) propose changes to FEI Statutes, Internal Regulations of the FEI, FEI General Regulations or Internal Regulations of the FEI Tribunal.

## **EVENTING RULES**
