Anne Murac is a Sport Cluster Manager at the Paris 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games Organising Committee. She is in charge of the Ile de France cluster, the location of Versailles, where the equestrian events will be held against the magnificent historical backdrop. Prior to joining the Paris 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games Organising Committee, Anne Murac was a director at Longines Paris Eiffel Jumping. She has over 15 years of experience as project manager and director at the Evian Golf Masters and Evian Championship.

Sylvie Robert

Project Director, GL Events Equestrian Sport

Sylvie Robert joined the GL Events Group in 1987. In 1995, one year after the acquisition of the Equita Lyon trade fair by the Group, Sylvie Robert took over as General Manager. Under Robert's management, GL Events organised the FEI World Cup Finals™ Jumping and Dressage in Lyon in 2014 and in Paris in 2018. As Director of Equestrian Events for the GL Events Group, Sylvie Robert became President of GL Events Equestrian Sport in 2017.

Jean Morel, GL Events Equestrian Sport

Jean Morel is an international athlete with over 20 years of experience on the French Dressage team. Since 2022, he has been the team's chef d'équipe.

Since 1979, Morel has managed PSV, which has acted as the official photo agency of the French Equestrian Federation (FFE) at the Olympic Games, FEI World Equestrian Games $^{\text{TM}}$ and FEI World Cup Finals $^{\text{TM}}$.

Jean Morel is highly skilled in the organisation of international equestrian events, including CSI5* Paris Porte de Versailles, where he served as event director from 1995 to 2008 as well as the FEI European Eventing Championships in Fontainebleau (FRA) in 2009. In 2008, he took over as the Director of the FFE Grand National in Jumping, Dressage and Eventing. That same year, he became the NF's head of partnerships.
