PARIS 2024 – Future of Eventing

- Safeguarding Eventing presence in the Olympic Program
- Increase interest and exposure of Eventing by ensuring a successful and competitive Olympic Games
- Evolve the worldwide perception of Eventing (from “going to war to survive” and Military tradition)
- Media interest- increase of viewership
- Ensure media support during Cross country with involvement and communication



PARIS 2024 –Eventing Participation

1. Nations having gained qualification (31 Dec. 2023)

EVENTING: 16 Team quota places allocated to NOCs: FRA (as host nation), GER, USA, NZL, GBR, IRL, SWE, SUI, BEL, NED, POL, CAN, BRA, AUS, JPN, ITA.

17 Individual Quota places (confirmed by FEI on 19 February)

Estimated total of NOC for Eventing: **29** (Team & Individual)

3 Olympic disciplines: Total **25** NOCs with Teams. Estimate: **47** nations (including individuals)

2. Timelines

All participating combinations must have obtained the required MERs by 24 June 2024 including a confirmation result obtained in 2024 on 4* or 5* Level. Ensure fitness to compete and recency of results.
