All forms need to be returned no later than 12 July 2019. Maximum number of horses per athlete is 2 unless otherwise agreed and confirmed with the Competition management.

The number of team members will be as below: One Athlete and Groom per Horse and One Chef d'Equipe, Coach and Veterinarian per Nation. The members who exceed this number shall participate as NOC observers, (refer to section 3).

E. Athletes Accreditation

Accreditation will be issued for every participant.

F. Veterinary information

1.1 Veterinary and farrier services

Veterinary services at EQP will be staffed by recognized veterinary specialists and delivered at a purpose-built veterinary clinic with a hospital for on-site emergency surgery. Veterinary dispensing pharmaceutical services, clinical laboratory services and diagnostic imaging service with digital radiography and ultrasonography will be available on site delivered at a purpose-built veterinary clinic with a hospital for on-site emergency surgery. Equine physiotherapist will also be available. Emergency veterinary clinical services will be available 24-hours a day while horses are stabled in Test Event stables. Veterinarians will cover the training arenas and field of play when they are open. In addition, a farrier service will be available on site. The farrier services will include a mobile forge and equipment.

1.2 National Federation Team Veterinarian

National Federations are required to register their Team Veterinarian (who must be qualified as PTV) with the Tokyo 2020 Veterinary Services by **12 July 2019**. This must include:

- First name, last name
- Nationality
- FEI ID number
- Contact information (email and mobile phone number)

The above information must be sent to Tokyo 2020's Vet Service Manager Dr. Hiroko Aida at hiroko.aida@tokyo2020.jp. Information will be shared with the veterinary clinic's administrator. Without the registration the Team Veterinarian will not be able to use veterinary clinic facilities, submit samples for clinical laboratory, or obtain veterinary stock.

All Team Veterinarians must always visibly wear their FEI Veterinarian identification card in addition

to their accreditation while in the venue.

1.3 Import of Veterinary Medicines and Quarantine Issues

All the information about the procedures for IMPORT OF VETERINARY MEDICINES and QUARANTINE ISSUES will share by the International Shipping Agent, Peden Bloodstock GmbH.

G. Feeds

A local supplier (JRA Facilities Co. Ltd., JRAF) has been appointed by Tokyo 2020 to sell horse feed and bedding at EQP. The available feed is listed in Appendix A. National Federations are required to email a Feed Purchase Order Form to Tokyo 2020 no later than 12 July 2019. Please note that some formula feed will need to be ordered by 6 June 2019. The additional order for the formula feed is not acceptable after 12 July 2019. The supplier will sell the other feed on site. Peden Bloodstock GmbH is in charge to gather and divulge the conditions and all the information about the process of importing feeds in Japan.

H. Bedding

Tokyo 2020 will provide the first bedding for all horses at both venues. The supplier will sell additional bedding at EQP. Currently, the bedding available in Tokyo is Wheat Straw from AUS, Wood Shavings from local market and Paper Bedding (newspaper) from the local market. Selection of bedding material should be informed to Tokyo 2020 also by the Feed Purchase Order Form.

I. Wireless Items

Those who wish to use their own wireless items, such as radio/walkie talkie brought from overseas, must inform Tokyo 2020 before arrival and no later than 1 August. Those items may not be allowed the spectrum in Japan under the "Radio Wave Management Law". Wi-Fi and Bluetooth devices are allowed without any checks.

5. HORSE TRANSPORTATION

Peden Bloodstock GmbH has been appointed to plan and transport overseas horses for this Test Event. They will also coordinate the inland transport between Narita International Airport (NRT) and EQP as well as for all horse transportation between EQP and SFC, except horses residing in Japan from the Isolation Stable to EQP.

Please note the following key points:

- All horses must arrive at EQP by 10 August 2019.
- Up to four horses will be placed in each lorry.
- Estimated travel times: NRT EQP: 90 minutes, EQP SFC: 60 minutes

A. Visas

B. Arrivals & Departures

Tokyo 2020 does not provide airport pick-up and drop-off services for Test Event, so public transport is recommended. There are two international airports in Tokyo area, both of which will be official ports of entry at Games time:

- Narita International Airport (NRT) is about 40-60 minutes from the city center by train, 90-120 minutes by airport limousine (Airport Bus service) and 60 minutes by taxi.
- <u>Tokyo International Airport (Haneda, HND)</u> is 15-30 minutes from the city center by train, 15-40 minutes by airport limousine (Airport Bus service) and 15 minutes by taxi.

C. Parking

As the parking spaces are very limited in both venues please let us know in advance if you are planning to arrive by car or taxi at the venues.
