Additional proposals for consideration

Goals

“We must allow elite horses to continue to perform at a high level without risking those horses that are unsuited and unprepared for elite competition.”

Allow *all* horses to go home safely

Allow elite horses to continue to perform at a high level

Venues with average speeds > 20 kph:

- Presentation times
10 min, 20 at finish



Qualifications

Incremental increases in speeds require stepping up qualifications

For venues with average speeds > 20 kph

- Qualifying speeds 16-20 kph
- Presentation times 10 min, 20 at finish



Qualifications

Horses qualified for 160 but out of competition > 1 year:

- Must re-qualify at a 80k level before stepping up



Measurement of loop speeds

Time out - Time in off the loop

VS

Time out - Time into Horse Inspections

- Gives more accurate measurement
- Does not include Recovery Time in

loop speed calculation



Veterinary matters

- -Expand Immediate Invasive Tx to include horses that Fail to Recover
- Serious Injury designation added to Minor Injury and Catastrophic Injury
- As an agreed condition of entry, include evaluation and 12-24 hour follow-up treatment at a referral facility , if necessary
