Discipline	Minimum Eligibility Requirements
JUMPING	In addition to the qualification procedure, Athletes and Horses not necessarily as combinations must obtain a Certificate of Capability at a CSI1* event or at a higher level event by obtaining a result of not more than eight penalties in the first round of a specifically nominated Competition 1.50m in height. Certificates of Capability may be obtained between 1 January in the year preceding the Pan-American Games (2014) until the date for nominated entries.
DRESSAGE	Horse/athlete combination must have achieved at least: Small Tour 62% panel score twice from 01 January 2014 in a CDN or CDI or at Games (Central American and Caribbean CAC, Odesur South American Games) at a minimum the same level test. CDN or CDI organized must have at least 2 FEI Judges of a nationality different other than the Athlete. Big Tour 58 % panel score from 01 January 2014 in a CDN or a CDI 2* or higher in a GP. CDN or CDI organized must have at least 2 FEI Judges of a nationality other than the Athlete.
EVENTING	Participants must obtained, as a combination, one reinforced CCI2* qualifying result (MER) between 1 st January 2014 and the nominated entries deadline. Dressage Test: A maximum of 65 penalty points Cross Country Test: Clear on Cross Country obstacles, not more than 90 seconds exceeding the optimum time Jumping Test: Not more than 16 penalties at obstacles
