- Minimum 5 years of equine veterinary experience
- Complete the online Endurance Foundation Course

Maintenance

- Licensure confirmation & good standing with the Veterinary Regulator of registration, via Annual **Disclosures Declaration**
- 1 CEI every 3 years as a Member of the Treating Veterinary Commission

- Pass a Transfer-up Level 2 Endurance Veterinary Treating Officials Course with examination(s)
- Shadow officiate* at 3 CEIs with at least 2 different FEI Mentor Officials (Level 3 or 4 Endurance Official Veterinarians, officiating as Members of the Veterinary Commission)
- Shadow officiate* at 3 CEIs with at least 2 different FEI Mentor Officials (Level 3 or 4 Endurance Veterinary Treating Officials)
- Complete the education process within 3 years \checkmark of application

*A positive recommendation is required for each shadow officiating


