

Rules for Winter Equestrian Festival (WEF) Finale Grand Prix Qualification

WEF Finale Qualification:

There are 10 qualifying events held in Wellington, FL (USA) for the WEF Finale Grand Prix at CSI5* Wellington, FL (USA) on 30 March-3 April 2016.

Points may be earned in the Grand Prix competition at each of the qualifying events according to the point scale outlined hereunder.

The top 25 in the Grand Prix at WEF events on weeks 2, 3, 6 and 10 (see events list below) will receive points as follows:

1st = 50, 2nd = 48, 3rd = 47, 4th = 46, 5th = 45, 6th = 44, etc. until 25th place.

WEF 3:	CSI3* Wellington	27-31 January 2016
WEF 6:	CSI3* Wellington	17-21 February 2016
WEF 10:	CSI3* Wellington	16-20 March 2016

The top 25 in the Grand Prix at WEF events on weeks 4, 5, 7, 8, 9 and 11 (see list of events below) will receive points as follows:

1st = 75, 2nd = 73, 3rd = 72, 4th = 71, 5th = 70, 6th = 69, etc. until 25th place.

WEF 11:	CSI4*/U25A Wellington	23-27 March 2016
WEF 12:	CSI5* Wellington (WEF Final)	30 March-3 April 2016

The final ranking will be based on the best four results of each athlete and from this ranking the top 40 athletes will be eligible to compete in the WEF Finale Grand Prix. If any athlete does not compete the next highest ranked athlete will become eligible. In the event of equality of points the athlete with the highest prize money won in the WEF Grand Prix competitions will be eligible.
