<b>1. Trot</b> Rhythm, suppleness, elasticity impulsion, swinging back, ground cover, ability to collect		
<b>2. Walk</b> Rhythm, relaxation, activity, ground cover		
<b>3. Canter</b> Rhythm, suppleness, elasticity, natural balance, impulsion, ability to collect, ground cover, uphill tendency		
<b>4. Submission</b> Standard of training on basis of "Training Scale" (suppleness, contact, straightness). Obedience, including the different movements. Transitions within the paces.		
<b>5. Perspective</b> Potential as dressage horse, ability to collect and take weight
