

#### 1. HIGHLIGHTS 2023

- Measures related to Equine Anti-Doping (51) still represent the biggest bulk (89.5%) of total cases handled by the FEI Tribunal (58).
- Significant increase in number of cases handled under the concept of "Consent Award". In total 44 Consent Awards approved by the FEI Tribunal, representing 86.2%, of the total 51 Equine Antidoping <u>Cases</u> and 75.8% of total cases handled.
- Up to date with ongoing cases. No pending case from previous year (i.e. 2022).
- Concluded process to review the Internal Regulations of the FEI Tribunal (Current version 2018)

#### 58 TOTAL CASES HANDLED: 51 Equine Positives and 7 Other related nature




## 2. FEI TRIBUNAL DECISIONS 2023 - a. Equine Positives

#### **Equine Positives: 51 Sanctions** (15 Banned Substances, 36 Controlled Medications)

#### **51** Sanctions (49 Decisions)

- 2 Cases resulted in no Sanction due to No Fault/Negligence findings.
- 12 Final Suspension of 18 Months (7 PRs & 5 Trainers)
- 2 Final Suspension of 12 Months (1 PR & 1 Trainer)
- 1 Final Suspension of 7 Months (Trainer)
- 1 Final Suspension of 6 Months (Trainer)
- 2 Final Suspension of 5 Months (1 PR & 1 Trainer)
- **3** Final Suspension of 4 Months (2 PRs & 1 Trainer)
- 28 Final Suspension of 3 Months (8 PRs & 20 Trainers)



## 2. FEI TRIBUNAL DECISIONS 2023 - a. Equine Positives



Average Suspension 2023 -> 7.04 Months

- 14.80 Months for Banned Substances
- 3.81 Months for Controlled Medications (2022 -> 6.75 Months; 2021 -> 13.80 Months)

## Average fine 2023 -> **CHF 2'736**

- CHF 3'667 for Banned Substances
- CHF 2'349 for Controlled Medications (2022-> CHF 2'713 ; 2021 -> CHF 3'961)

## 3 Preliminary Decisions

- 2 Preliminary Decisions involving Controlled Medication & Banned Substance Cases. Lifting of Provisional Suspensions were denied.
- 1 Preliminary Decision involving a Safeguarding matter. Lifting of Provisional Suspension.
- 3 Decisions in connection with an Appeal
- 3 Agreements submitted to the FEI Tribunal for approval

#### 4. CAS APPEALS & DECISIONS

#### CAS Decisions issued: 3 Final Arbitral Awards

- 1 Disciplinary case: Abuse of Horse, Criminal Act, Conduct that brings the FEI and /or Equestrian Sport into Disrepute. FEI Tribunal Decision Confirmed (10 years suspension).
- 1 Rules interpretation case: Challenge the validity of the FEI WBFSH Dressage World Breeding Championships for Young Horses Guidelines. FEI Tribunal Decision Confirmed.
- 1 Field of Play case: Request for Reconsideration of Endurance Penalty Points.
  Appeal partially upheld.
- 1 Withdrawn case by Appellant: appeal against a field of play decision.
